



6. Work location & targets:

- A secure place can be organized for the seed and storage bag to be distributed.
- The security context allows beneficiaries to safely access the point of distribution.
- Space to accommodate people (including the availability of shade, cleaning facilities, etc.) The context needs to be secure enough for beneficiaries to carry seeds back home for planting Accessibility for participants, including estimated travel and wait times.












Terms of Payment& Taxes:
